## MEASURING FORM



the Netherlands


A - Height:

 B - Total body length: Stand straight with your bare feet exactly 15 cm apart. Measure from your thorax (located at the base of your neck between your clavicles) to the floor.

- C Inside leg: Stand straight with your feet 15 cm apart.
  Place a book perpendicular to the floor under you perineum.
  - apply similar pressure to that of a saddle.
  Measure from the spine of the book to the floor.
- D Shoulder width: Arms tight against the body, please measure between the edges of your scapula (shoulder blades).
- E Knee height: Sitting with bare feet at a 90° angle flush against a wall with your heels under your knees at a 90° angle, measure between the upper part of your knee to the floor.
- F Arm length:

Make a fist. Hold your arms outstretched in a 90° angle as illustrated. Place a book underneath your armpit with a little pressure up. Measure from book cover (against your body) to the tip of your knuckles. Keep arms straight at all times.
